The designed system that produced visual feedback of two belt pulleys that had to be aligned within 0.5mm of each other, has received very positive feedback from Thermo King, to such an extent they have now invited the Clavis team to help resolve another production requirement.

Keen to ensure brand recognition and consistency across the product range, Mark is in the process of implementing the company's sleek new look from their latest brand refresh.
